Teachers Joke Rood and Tjitske Muller. They both successfully completed the Leadership course at the school for Playback Theatre in New York in 2008.

'The moment that all playback free timers start to think about a part-or full time playback job, the impact of playback theatre, as a positive vibe in this world, will grow. That's what the world needs now!' If you start to do playback for a living, you will be able to invest more lifetime in your playback work because you earn money with it.

This is a strong motivation of Joke and Tjitske to offer this course. They are part- and fulltime Playbackers themselves and like to inspire playback people to examine the possibilities in their own specific situation.

In this laboratory of dreams and real life we will examine (by playback theatre) together what the chances and threats are, in combination with marketing theories tested against the practical experience in working life. Joke as a marketing professional in arts and Tjitske as the founding director of the first professional Playback Theatre company in Holland (Thread Theatre) like to share their knowledge and experience.

We'd like to invite you to Amsterdam to meet each other in work, but also in free time. We'll stay in a very nice houseboat en we'll work in the centre of Amsterdam. On the day of arrival, we'll unpack and meet. The next day, we'll start with the course.

The program in short:

1 May: Arrival day

From 15.00. Meet and greet each other in Amsterdam. In the evening we'll offer you a captain's meal on board.

2 May: Course day 1

- * Exchange images of our actual company life *
- * A survey about your relationship with money. What does money mean to you and what does it say about your feelings of asking money for a performance? We'll do play back of course in this survey.
- * A boat trip at 17.00 if the weather is okay. And dinner in town.

3 May: Course day 2

- * A survey about your knowledge of playback as a product, markets, marketing.
 - * In the evening a playback performance by Theater Draad and Wordt Vervolgd

4 May: Course day 3

- * Integration of knowledge. Tools for the future. We'll stop at 15.00 in the afternoon.
- * Evening programme to discuss or departure and say good bye.
